ASEE Engineering Postdoctoral Fellowship (eFellows)

Goal: To support projects and applicants whose work combines Al with research projects in traditional fields of engineering. They are also interested in supporting projects that have an impact on rural areas in the United States.

The program's focus has recently been changed to establish fellowships in EPSCoR jurisdictions, like NM.

Deadline: Oct 31

NM EPSCoR: SURE Awards

Goal: To increase student and faculty access to meaningful research experiences by providing small scale awards to individual faculty. Funding can be used for student researchers, acquisition of research supplies, student conference travel, and summer salary/course buyout. **Amount:** Up to \$16,500

NM NASA EPSCoR Research Infrastructure Development Funding

Goal: To provide funding to develop competitive research, technology projects, and programs for the solution of scientific and technical problems of importance to NASA. Each Research Infrastructure Development (RID) project must align with NASA's Research Areas of Interest. **Amount:** Up to \$25K for 1-year total duration.

Deadline: Rolling

NSF: Innovation in Two-Year College STEM Education (ITYC)

Goal: To center students in the effort to advance innovation and promote success in STEM education at two-year colleges, and enhance the capacity of two-year colleges to harness the talent and potential of their student and faculty populations. **Amount:** \$500k for up to 3 years

NSF Focused EPSCoR Collaborations Program

Goal: To support interjurisdictional teams of EPSCoR investigators to perform research in topics that align with NSF priorities, with the goals of driving discovery and building sustainable STEM capacity. Project must involve investigators from two or more EPSCoR jurisdictions; coordinate with home institution to ensure compliance with proposal limits per institution. **Amount:** Two jurisdictions → \$1M a year for up to 4 years. Three or more → \$1.5 a year for up to 4 years.

The Science Ambassador Scholarship (women and non-binary students in STEM)

Goal: To provide a one-time college tuition stipend to support high school seniors or undergrad students. Applicants do not have to be U.S. citizens, however do need to attend college (or plan to attend college) in the United States or a United States Territory.
